### 2014 SPONSORSHIP DRIVE

DAV Tucson Chapter 4 seeks sponsorships to support our services to local veterans. We offer our services on a 100% volunteer basis with no cost to veterans served. DAV Service Officers are disabled veterans themselves, and must be trained and recertified annually. DAV Tucson Chapter 4 serves veterans in Northern Pima County and Southern Pinal County, including Northwest Tucson, Marana, Catalina, Oro Valley, and outlying areas.

- 94,083** **Number of veterans residing in Pima County, Arizona.** DAV services are available free of charge to every one of these citizens. Of these, about 17,000 have a service-connected disability.
- 25,000** **Annual dollars needed to keep our office open,** including rent, utilities, insurance, and supplies. Our office is open 5 days per week, soon to be expanded to include evening and weekend hours.
- 8,500** **Annual operating costs for our Mobile Office.** Our fully-equipped RV office serves veterans in outlying areas and can frequently be seen at local events promoting awareness of our services.
- 4,800** **Dollars provided directly to veterans** for emergency assistance in 2013; funds are provided to cover basic needs such as food, clothing, shelter, and transportation for veterans in need.
- 4,900** **Hours of volunteer service given by Chapter 4 Service Officers, Members and Volunteers in 2013,** including direct-to-veteran services, fundraising, administrative services, and public relations.
- 400** **Number of veterans served by our Chapter last year.** Veterans and their families receive assistance with VA Claims, life transitions, transportation, medical devices, and so much more.
- 100** **Percent of your donation dollars which remain local.** DAV Chapter 4 serves your family, your friends, your neighbors, your work associates, your local business people. Right here at home.
- 98** **Percent of operating expenses covered by local donations.** We receive a small annual income from DAV National. Unlike many veterans' organizations, we do not operate a bar for income.
- 7** **Number of Annually Certified Service Officers providing service directly to veterans** through our Chapter in 2013. Five new volunteers are in training for the August 2014 certification exam.
- 0** **The amount we charge for our services.** All services are provided at no cost to veterans and their families, made possible by the volunteerism of our members and the generosity of our donors.
